- SSRA (Larry Metz) -
  - Updates on coverage for fall programming:
    - Sept only had 11 rec games without a center
      - 4 Seattle United games not covered (lower age groups)
    - Oct 49 MOD soccer games not covered (U10-U12)
      - Harder to manage because environment is chaotic (subs, parent comments, etc.)
      - Refs would rather get paid less and be AR on older games
      - Refs are saying teams are saying they do not have to bring rosters
      - 3 Seattle United games not covered (lower age groups)

- We are getting a report about 1x a week this year on sideline behavior. Mostly about adult behavior toward younger refs.
- We have been receiving notifications of red cards, but without names, hard to follow up when we don't have names.
